Cinnamon Toast

For each serving you will need:
2 slices of bread
Butter
Cinnamon
Sugar

Toast the bread slices.

As soon as they come out of the toaster, butter slices. Butter on the toast slices needs to be more than a light buttering in order to be able to hold the cinnamon and sugar mixture on the toast.

Sprinkle a fair amount of cinnamon on each slice. Adding the cinnamon before the sugar allows you to use less sugar. After all, it *is* called "Cinnamon Toast" and not "Sugar Toast". ~lol~

Sprinkle a little bit of sugar on each slice.

Using a regular table knife, mix the cinnamon and sugar together on each slice while also pressing mixture into the toast. This helps keep the cinnamon and sugar on the toast where it tastes better than having fallen on to the plate. ~wink~

Eat and savor the great cinnamon taste.

Notes:

- * My motto is "The more cinnamon the better". Many people don't realize just how great cinnamon is until they try a bit more than they are used to. Spice your toast the way your taste buds enjoy.
- * Why two slices per serving? You obviously haven't eaten one of these slices yet. One is just not enough!
