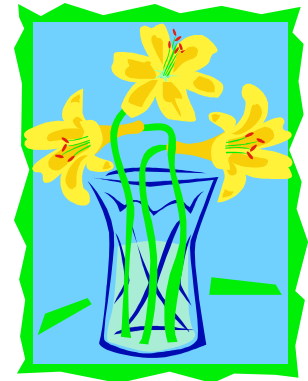


Storage Solution – Flower Vases

Find yourself running out of storage space? One of the items I've seen take up a good amount of space in various homes is flower vases. My husband has blessed me with many sets of flowers during the years we've been together, so I've also run into this dilemma.

Solution – keep only one or two clear vases (mine are glass) and get rid of the rest. For the one or two that you keep, ensure that they also have a design that you like. The two that I have decided to keep are each a different design, but they are complimentary so that if I want to have them both out at the same time they will harmonize.



If you don't already have a set of colored marbles or "river glass" or something similar, they are available in craft stores and in many other stores – usually at a fairly low price. Use the color from the marbles or glass pieces to provide seasonal and holiday color or just to provide color-matching or contrast for your normal decorating scheme.

You can also add food coloring to the water to tint it different colors, but be aware that flowers may change color as they drink up the tinted water.
