

Storing Celery

Back in my twenties, I remember reading a magazine reader's tip about wrapping celery in aluminum foil to store it longer. I never used that tip until about 5 years ago when I started having to keep celery frequently on hand. Unfortunately, I typically only use a stalk at a time, so I was only getting two or three uses out of a full head of celery before it turned to mush. Now, I wrap my celery in aluminum foil when I get home. I can actually keep a head for a couple of months before it goes bad. When I need a stalk, I just open the foil, peel off the stalk I need, and close the foil back up.

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
